### Point of Sale (POS) equipment

The Washington State Liquor Control Board (WSLCB) determined that the POS equipment will remain at current store locations as part of the fixtures and furniture. The hard drives will be cleaned all state POS information will be deleted. The DVRs will also remain on-site, but the hard drives will be removed.

Pin-pads (debit/credit device), routers, and multi-function device printers will also be removed by the WSLCB. They are not considered part of the fixtures and furniture remaining at the current store location.
